



# Commercial Driver License Document Requirements for Non-Immigrants

You must bring specific forms of proof of identification, Social Security, and residential address.

## Primary Identification

Original or certified copy. No photocopies.

- Unexpired foreign passport
- AND**
- Form I-94/I-94A with an unexpired "Admit Until Date." With one of the following non-immigrant classifications:
    - H-2A (Temporary Agricultural Workers)
    - H-2B (Temporary Non-Agricultural Workers)
    - E-2 (Treaty Investors)

## ONE Social Security Number

Must contain full social security number

- Original Social Security Card
- W-2 Form
- Pay Stub
- SSA-1099
- Non-SSA-1099

**NOTE:** Documents presented must have been valid for at least 60 days prior to applying for a driver license. Non-US citizens applying for an original driver license may be issued a 30-day, no photo, paper temporary permit & a receipt. Non-US citizens applying for an identification card will be issued a receipt. All records are transmitted to our database in Tallahassee, where the information will be examined & run against FDLE, FBI, and USCIS databases. Upon identity & legal status verification, a driver license or identification card will be issued within 30 days from Tallahassee, mailed to the address on the record. The license or identification card will be issued for a period of time specified on the USCIS document, up to a maximum of 1 year. If a problem is detected, a denial of issuance letter will be mailed to the customer.

**Name Change:** If you have legally changed your name by marriage or court order, you must have your name changed on your U.S. Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS) documents.

## TWO Proofs of Florida Residential Address - All proofs must be in your name Must present one proof from List A and one from List B, or two proofs from List A

Electronic notices are accepted. Please print & bring with you.

### List A

- A recent lease or rental agreement for the residence with a term of 6 months or greater in the name of the driver
- Florida vehicle registration or title
- Florida vessel registration or title
- Current homeowner's insurance policy or bill
- Current utility bill (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Recent cellular or landline telephone bill (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Recent internet service provider bill (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Latest property tax bill
- Mortgage deed for property in Florida

### List B

- Latest W-2 form or 1099 form (must be dated within the last 6 months)
- Recent bank statement (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Recent credit card statement (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Latest military orders or documents
- Recent pay stub (must be dated within the last 60 days)
- Recent official government documents (must be dated within the last 60 days)

Applicants unable to provide a proof of residential address from list A can provide a Declaration of Domicile filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court AND one proof of residential address document from List B.

### Important Notes:

- CLP & CDL applicants **cannot** use a Certification of Address (HSMV-71120) for licensure.
- CLP & CDL applicants upgrading from a Class E or ID card must resubmit acceptable proof of residential address.
